

**DELRAN BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS
CAUCUS MEETING
MARCH 9, 2020**

The meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District #1 was held on Tuesday evening, March 9, 2021 at the fire district office.

Vice President Joseph Parento, commencing with the flag salute called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The Vice President announced that this meeting is being conducted within the provisions of N.J.S. 10-4.6 to N.J.S. 10:4-41 titled Open Public Meetings and that the time and place has been posted on the bulletin board of the Municipal Building, and was advertised in the Burlington County Times on February 10, 2021.

Other members of the Board of Fire Commissioners and appointed persons present were Commissioners; James Bauer, Anthony Quaciari, James Turcich. Also, present were: Chief Kevin Peak; Deputy Chief Joseph Cunningham Sr.; Battalion Chief #231 Scott Seybert; Lt. #232 Dugme, and Lt.#232 C.J. Francis. Fire Commissioner Kendra was in the hospital. Battalion Chief #232 Daniel Pfeiffer and Captain #232 Joe Cunningham were excused.

COMMUNICATIONS- All communications that have been received by the Board were distributed.

SECRETARY – Commissioner Bauer reported that the Clerk is working on the group life insurance policy for active firefighters

CHIEF- Chief Peak submitted his written report. (See attached.)

DEPUTY CHIEF- Deputy Chief Joseph Cunningham submitted his written report. (See attached).

BATTALION CHIEF #231- Battalion Chief Seybert reported that he has several S.C.B.A. bottles that need hydrostat testing.

BATTALION Chief #232- no report.

FIRE EQUIPMENT- Commissioner Quaciari reported the Hurst Tools, air bags from the Safety grant were delivered, but only some Body Armor was received.

E.V.T. – Commissioner Parento reported that #2312's windshield and tires were replaced.

FIRE POLICE- Fire Police Captain Bobby Borsuk reported that the county fire police meeting scheduled at Station #231 was cancelled due to the Covid-19 restrictions.

NEW BUSINESS – Civil Service has begun testing to hire firefighters again.

EXECUTIVE SESSION – Commissioner Turcich made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Quaciari to enter into closed session under N.J.S.A.10:4-12 to discuss personnel matters. It was stated that the matters to be discussed would be made public when the interests of the District no longer exist to retain the matters as confidential.
