

**DELRAN BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS  
CAUCUS MEETING  
JANUARY 12, 2020**

The meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District #1 was held on Tuesday evening, January 12, 2021 at the fire district office.

Vice President Joseph Parento, commencing with the flag salute called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The Vice President announced that this meeting is being conducted within the provisions of N.J.S. 10-4.6 to N.J.S. 10:4-41 titled Open Public Meetings and that the time and place has been posted on the bulletin board of the Municipal Building, and was advertised in the Burlington County Times on February 26, 2020.

Other members of the Board of Fire Commissioners and appointed persons present were Commissioners; James Bauer, Anthony Quaciari, James Turcich. Also, present were: Chief Kevin Peak; Deputy Chief Joseph Cunningham Sr.; Battalion Chief #231 Scott Seybert; Battalion Chief #232 Daniel Pfeiffer; Lt. #232 Joe Cunningham; and Lt. Dugme. Fire Commissioner Kendra was in the hospital.

COMMUNICATIONS- All communications that have been received by the Board were distributed.

CHIEF- Chief Peak submitted his written report. (See attached.)

Chief Peak stated that the department has responded to 14 calls for the new year. He also asked if the Board had made a decision on fire department personnel driving station 239 ambulances on emergency calls. Fire Commissioner VP Joseph Parento stated that no decision had been made; the Board is still gathering information.

DEPUTY CHIEF- Deputy Chief Joseph Cunningham reported that #2323, and #2329 repairs have been made.

BATTALION CHIEF #231- Battalion Chief Seybert reported that he is off to a good start, setting up procedures to lower response times.

BATTALION Chief #232- Chief Pfeiffer stated he is working on a boat training lesson.

LINE OFFICERS REPORT- Lt. Joe Cunningham. (Due to Covid-19 meeting restrictions), Station #3232 was unable to meet. Capt6ain will send new membership application to the Board Clerk. He asked if PSTRAX could show how the Delran Fire Department is using their report system to other departments. Commissioner Parento told Captain Cunningham to notify PSTRAX that it had our permission to show how we use their system. Lt. Dugme stated that he is looking forward to serve our department as second lieutenant.

FIRE EQUIPMENT- Commissioner Parento advised to get with Chief Peak and Trustee Borsuk reported that the batteries for the floor machine have not come in yet. Commissioner Turcich stated that he was not aware of any batteries on order.

E.V.T. – Commissioner Parento reported that the new light bar for Ladder #2315 is on 6 week back order.

UNIFORMS Commissioner Quaciari reported that the badges ordered were received and handed out.

FIRE POLICE- Fire Police Captain Borsuk advised the Board that #2318 needs a arrow stick. I will take #2317 to the inspection station for vehicle inspection.

Captain Cunningham reported to Captain Borsuk that the Chester Ave. station has a arrow stick they are not using to pick it up.
