

**DELRAN BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS
CAUCUS MEETING
NOVEMBER 9, 2021**

The meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District #1 was held on Tuesday evening November 9, 2021 at the fire district office.

President Joseph Parento, commencing with the flag salute called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The President announced that this meeting is being conducted within the provisions of N.J.S. 10-4.6 to N.J.S. 10:4-41 titled Open Public Meetings and that the time and place has been posted on the bulletin board of the Municipal Building, and was advertised in the Burlington County Times on February 10, 2021.

Other members of the Board of Fire Commissioners and appointed persons present were Commissioners; James Bauer, Anthony Quaciari, James Turcich. Also, present were: Captain #232 Joseph Cunningham Jr.; Lieutenants #232 Dugme and Francis. Fire Commissioner Kendra was excused.

Commissioner Turcich made a motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Quaciari to order lights for (2) two Kubdota RTV’s . The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was carried.

Commissioner Parento advised the Board that the Delran Police were interested in our fire police trailer. Commissioner Turcich made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Quaciari to retitle the trailer to the Delran Township. The Board was polled. All AYE. The motion was carried.
