MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

FEBRUARY 22, 2022

The monthly meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District No. 1 was held on Tuesday evening February 22, 2022, at the Fire District office.

President Joe Parento, commencing with the flag salute, called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The President announced that this meeting is being conducted within the provisions of N.J.S. 10-4.6 to N.J.S. 10-4-41 titled Open Public Meetings and that the time and place has been posted on the bulletin board of the Municipal Building and was advertised in the Burlington County Times on February 10, 2021.

Other members of the Board and appointed persons were Commissioners James Turcich, Anthony Quaciari and James Bauer; Chief Peak; Deputy Chief Cunningham; Captain #232 Cunningham; Lt. #231 Bensel and Lt. #232 Dugme.

CHIEF- Chief Peak submitted his written report.

DEPUTY CHIEF- Deputy Chief submitted his written report.

LINE OFFICERS- Captain Cunningham reported that the foam system on 2324 is working at 70%. He request that we paint lines on Chester Avenue reading "Fire Station Do Not Block Driveway" do to the condos being built on Holy Cross's property. Lt. Dugme requested shirts and patches for his trip to Turkey, so he can trade with fire companies. Hearing no objections, President Parento granted this request.

FIRE OFFICIAL- Walt Bauer stated that the reports for 2021 were filed with the New Jersey Division of Fire Safety.

INSURANCE- Ryan Jones submitted his written report.

BILLS FOR PAYMENT- A motion was made by Commissioner Turcich and seconded by Commissioner Quaciari to pay all bills present. The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was carried.

TREASURER REPORT- A motion was made by James Turcich and seconded by Commissioner Quaciari to accept the Treasurer report. The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was carried.

Commissioner Turcich reported that the gym equipment is being repaired. He received a quote from Midlantic of \$6,073.83 and \$1,840 for option to install back flow valves at Station 231.

E.V.T.-Kobota recall for floor mats that could interfere with throttle pedal.

MASTER PLAN- Commissioner Bauer stated a meeting will held in April.

GRANT- We are currently working on the Safer Grant.

NEW BUSINESS- Fire Official Bauer wants to raise the registration rates for non-life safety use groups to cover inspection expenses. Commissioner Quaciari is looking to get a floor machine from General Chemical.

OLD BUSINESS- Working on gov.deals. I am Responding is looking to stop shut downs.

President Parento asked if anyone had any future business to discuss. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Turcich made a motion seconded by Commissioner Quaciari to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 pm. The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was approved.
