

**DELRAN BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS
CAUCUS MEETING
June 14, 2022**

The meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District #1 was held on Tuesday evening, June 14, 2022 at the fire district office.

President Joseph Parento, commencing with the flag salute called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The President announced that this meeting is being conducted within the provisions of N.J.S. 10-4.6 to N.J.S. 10:4-41 titled Open Public Meetings and that the time and place has been posted on the bulletin board of the Municipal Building, and was advertised in the Burlington County Times on February 19, 2022.

Other members of the Board of Fire Commissioners and appointed persons present were Commissioners; James Bauer, Anthony Quaciari, James Turcich. Also, Officers present were: Chief Peak, Deputy Chief Joseph Cunningham, Captain #232 Joseph Cunningham, #231 Lt. Bensel, and #232 Lt. Dugme.

COMMUNICATIONS- All communications that have been received by the Clerk were distributed.

CHIEF- Chief Peak submitted his written report.

DEPUTY CHIEF- Red Balloon Day Care requested a firetruck to come out in July for a wet down and go over trucks.

OFFICERS- Captain Cunningham #232 the new AED's are on the trucks, we sending personnel to be become C.P.R. Instructors. Lt. Bensel #231 reported that there is a block on air line on 2315 and will be replaced.

FIRE OFFICIAL- the Fire Officials have been using their own cameras and they are about 20 years old, we are in the process of replacing the cameras for investigating purposes.

PUBLIC RELATIONS- The chief reported that Delran Fire Department attended the car show and grand reopening of grocery outlet on RT#130 Millside Plaza.

E.V.T. – Commissioner Parento reported that 1) 2312's is unable to draft foam; the line is clogged. Fire & Safety will be out. 2) There was a long discussion on the hose that failed the annual test. A spec will be written to replace the hose.

BILLS FOR PAYMENT- Commissioner Quaciari made a motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Bauer for the Treasurer to pay all bills present. The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was carried.

WEB- The Chief reported that it is a stand still.

GRANT – Water Company grant was rejected.

FIREPOLICE- Next meeting is in Lumberton. Our Firepolice helped Mansfield with their Community Day.

OLD BUSINESS- Knox boxes are being updated, no time line reported.

NEW BUSINESS- none

Delran Fire Department Department Chiefs Report

June 14, 2022

Currently we are at 290 calls for the year.

May 30th – Bridgeboro road station was struck out for a apartment fire in Moorestown. Crew arrived and staged for a short time before being released and being routed to an MVC in town at Haines Mill Rd and Route 130.

June 4th the Delran Grocery Outlet had a Grand Re-Opening and was attended by Delran Fire Personnel.

June 4th also was a car show that the fire department was asked to be in attendance for and this was also handled by fire department personnel. Thanks to Lt. Parento and Capt. Cunningham Jr. for handing these assignments.

The department took place in the Delanco Parade and Riverside Parades this past Memorial Day.

PSE&G will begin the milling and re paving project on Chester Avenue in the coming weeks after school is out for the Summer Break. Once more precise time frames and dates are announced information will be sent out to the department.

I was reached out to by Brian Iannacone once again in regards to Delran participating in conjunction with the HazMat Team for Decon purposes on their assessments being that we have the Rehab Trailer. I will be reaching back out to him to set up a meeting and see what all is entailed.

The Fire Marshal's office has been busy with a lot of work; one part being all of the alarm systems that we have recently had with the new FoxTail Creek area. This work has cleared up a lot of issues and have streamlined how the alarm system will be monitored and how we handle certain calls. Many thanks to DFO Cunningham Jr for the work and information put out for different aspects around town.

New AED's have been purchased and have been received by the district office. These units will be going in the 6 large apparatus (2311, 2312, 2315, 2321, 2324, 2329) and the two command units. Training on these units have already begun and will continue so that all know what to expect if the time comes to use one.

August 2nd is the National Night Out this year that will be held in Delran Community Park on Hartford Road. The Delran Fire Department again will be playing a part in this in traffic control and also hazard mitigation and standby for the duration of the event. We have already had one meeting in regards to this event with township officials; more information will be made available when it is available.
