

**DELRAN BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS  
CAUCUS MEETING  
AUGUST 9, 2022**

The meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District #1 was held on Tuesday evening, August 9, 2022 at the fire district office.

President Joseph Parento, commencing with the flag salute called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The President announced that this meeting is being conducted within the provisions of N.J.S. 10-4.6 to N.J.S. 10:4-41 titled Open Public Meetings and that the time and place has been posted on the bulletin board of the Municipal Building, and was advertised in the Burlington County Times on February 19, 2022.

Other members of the Board of Fire Commissioners and appointed persons present were Commissioners; James Bauer, and James Turcich. Also, Officers present were: Chief Peak and Deputy Chief Joseph Cunningham Sr. Commissioner Tony Quaciari was excused.

COMMUNICATIONS- All communications that have been received by the Clerk were distributed.

CHIEF- Chief Peak submitted his written report. He also reported that the call at Tenby Towne Apartments was found to be a leaking acetylene tank.
