

DELRAN BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS  
SPECIAL MEETING FOR FIRE DISTRICT BUDGET  
January 17, 2023

A meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District No. 1 was held on January 17, 2023 at the Fire District Office.

President Joseph Parento called the meeting to order at 7:36 pm.

The President announced that this meeting is being conducted with the provisions of N.J.S. 10-4.6 to N.J.S. 10:4-41 titled Open Public Meetings and that the time and place has been posted on the bulletin board of the Municipal Building, and was advertised in the Burlington County Times on January 11, 2023.

James Turcich made a motion, seconded by Anthony Quaciari to adopt the proposed 2023 budget (Resolution 2023-06). The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was carried.

Battalion Chief Cunningham- We have 2 members that need Class A pants and some buttons. There was a discussion about class A's in general and needing to get some for many members especially for funerals. All of the board agreed that all of the officers should get their uniforms updated with buttons and horns and such. The officers within the next few months will get a form together for the membership to fill out if they need a uniform. There was also a discussion about stripes on the all the chief's uniform. As of now only the chief of the department is able to get stripes. The board will discuss this and make a decision.

The drone will be mailed tomorrow for us to demo for a week.

Aidan Friddell received his state inspector certification today. The board agreed to allow him to start doing inspections.
