1ii	Type 1 Torch	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The use of a torch or flame-producing device to remove paint from, or seal membrane roofs on, any building or structure;
1iii	Type 1 Occasional Use of Property	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The occasional use of any non-residential occupancy other than Use Groups F, H or S for group overnight stays of persons over 2 1/2 years of age, in accordance with section F-709.0 of the Fire Prevention Code
1iv	Type 1 Kiosks in Malls	54.00	Type 1 Permit-Individual portable kiosks or displays when erected in a covered mall for a period of less than 90 days, and when not covered by a Type 2 permit
1ix	Type 1 Occasional Use of Mutli- Purpose Room	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The occasional use in any building of a multipurpose room, with a maximum permitted occupancy of 100 or more for amusement, entertainment or mercantile type purposes.
1v	Type 1 Open flame, public venue	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The use of any open flame or flame-producing device, in connection with any public gathering, for purposes of entertainment, amusement, or recreation
1vi	Type 1 Welding Permit	54.00	Type 1 Permit-Welding or cutting operations except where the welding or cutting is performed in areas approved for welding by the fire official and is registered as a type B life hazard use
1vii	Type 1 Explosive/Blasting Agents	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The possession or use of explosives or blasting agents, other than model rocketry engines regulated under N.J.A.C. 12:194
1viii	Type 1 Open Flame for training non FF personnel	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The use of any open flame or flame-producing device in connection with the training of non-fire service personnel in fire suppression or extinguishment procedures
1x	Type 1 Storage/Handling Class 1 flammable 10 to 660 gal. inside/60 to 660 outside	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The storage or handling of class I flammable liquids in closed containers of aggregate amounts of more than 10 gallons, but not more than 660 gallons inside a building, or more than 60 gallons, but not more than 660 gallons outside a building
1xi	Type 1 Storage/Handling Class II or IIIA 25 to 660 gal. inside/60 to 660 outside	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The storage or handling of class II or IIIA combustible liquids in closed containers of aggregate amounts of more than 25 gallons, but not more than 660 gallons inside a building, or more than 60 gallons, but not more than 660 gallons outside a building
1xii	Type 1 Cooking permit, non life hazards. (Restaurants & Foodtrucks)	54.00	Type 1 Permit-Any permanent cooking operation that requires a suppression system in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:70-4.7(g) and is not defined as a life hazard use in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.4.
1xiii	Type 1 Public assembly in farm bldg	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The use as a place of public assembly, for a total of not more than 15 days in a calendar year, of a building classified as a commercial farm building under the Uniform Construction Code



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1xiv	Type 1 Temp use of build for amusement	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The temporary use of any building or portion thereof as a special amusement building for a total of not more than 15 days in a calendar year
1xv	Type 1 Tent 16,800 sq ft or more, or 140 ft in any direction, used 180 days or more	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The erection, operation, or maintenance of any tent, tensioned membrane structure, or canopy, excluding those used for recreational camping purposes, that meets the criteria in (a)3xv(1) or (2) below shall require a Type 1 permit. Tents, tensioned membrane structures, or canopies greater than 16,800 square feet in area or greater than 140 feet in any dimension, whether one unit or composed of multiple units; remaining in place for more than 180 days; used or occupied between December 1 and March 31; having a permanent anchoring system or foundation; or containing platforms or bleachers greater than 11 feet in height shall be subject to the permitting requirements of the Uniform Construction Code (N.J.A.C. 5:23-2.14).
1xvi	Type 1 Outdoor maze	54.00	Type 1 Permit-The erection, operation, or maintenance of any outdoor combustible maze shall require a Type 1 permit if the outdoor combustible maze is less than six feet in height and does not contain electrical equipment. Outdoor combustible mazes that are six feet or greater in height or contain electrical equipment shall be subject to the permitting requirements of N.J.A.C. 5:23-2.14
2i	Type 2 Bowling lane resurface/pin refinishing	214.00	Type 2 Permit-Bowling lane resurfacing and bowling pin refinishing involving the use and application of flammable liquids or materials
2ii	Type 2 Fumigation	214.00	Type 2 Permit-Fumigation or thermal insecticide fogging
2iii	Type 2 Carnivals enclosed structure for occupancy	214.00	Type 2 Permit-Carnivals and circuses employing mobile enclosed structures used for human occupancy
2iv	Type 2 Special use of covered mall for kioskes, booths, assembly, open flame, display of fueled equipment, LP gas	214.00	Type 2 Permit-The use of a covered mall in any of the following manners: (1) Placing or constructing temporary kiosks, display booths, concession equipment or the like in more than 25 percent of the common area of the mall; (2) Temporarily using the mall as a place of assembly; (3) Using open flame or flame devices; (4) Displaying liquid or gas fuel powered equipment; or (5) Using liquefied petroleum gas, liquefied natural gas or compressed flammable gas in containers exceeding five pound capacity.

3i	Type 3 Industrial Processing Oves less then 1,400 degrees fahrenheit	427.00	Type 3 Permit-Industrial processing ovens or furnaces operating at approximately atmospheric pressures and temperatures not exceeding 1,400 degrees Fahrenheit which are heated with oil or gas fuel or which contain flammable vapors from the product being processed



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3ii	Type 3 Wrecking/Junk Yards, outside storage of unclassified materials	427.00	Type 3 Permit-Wrecking yards, junk yards, outdoor used tire storage, waste material handling plants, and outside storage of forest products not otherwise classified
3iii	Type 3 Storage or discharging Fireworks	427.00	Type 3 Permit-The storage or discharging of fireworks
3iv	iv. Unoccupied or vacant buildings or structures 100,000 square feet or more in gross floor area.	427.00	iv. Unoccupied or vacant buildings or structures 100,000 square feet or more in gross floor area.
4i	Type 4 Storage compressed gas 2,000 CF or more Flammable or 6,000 CF non-flammable	641.00	Type 4 Permit-Storage or use at normal temperature and pressure of more than 2,000 cubic feet of flammable compressed gas or 6,000 cubic feet of nonflammable compressed gas
4ii	Type 4 Production, Sale, storage of more than 10 gals of cryogenic liquids	641.00	Type 4 Permit-The production or sale of cryogenic liquids; the storage or use of more than 10 gallons of liquid oxygen, flammable cryogenic liquids or cryogenic oxidizers; or the storage of more than 500 gallons of nonflammable, non-toxic cryogenic liquids
4iii	Type 4 Storage, handling or processing, flammable, combustible, unstable liquids in containers more than 660 gallons	641.00	Type 4 Permit-The storage, handling, and processing of flammable, combustible, and unstable liquids in closed containers and portable tanks in aggregate amounts of more than 660 gallons
4iv	Type 4 Store, handle 55 gals corrosives, 500 lbs oxidizers, 10 lbs organic peroxides, 500 lbs nitromethane, 1,000 lbs ammonium nitrate, 10 lbs of radioactive mater, 10 lbs of flammable solids	641.00	Type 4 Permit-To store or handle (except medicines, beverages, foodstuffs, cosmetics, and other common consumer items, when packaged according to commonly accepted practices): (1) More than 55 gallons of corrosive liquids; (2) More than 500 pounds of oxidizing materials; (3) More than 10 pounds of organic peroxides; (4) More than 500 pounds of nitromethane; (5) More than 1,000 pounds of ammonium nitrate; (6) More than one microcurie of radium not contained in a sealed source; (7) More than one millicurie of radium or other radiation material in a sealed source or sources; (8) Any amount of radioactive material for which a specific license from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission is required; or (9) More than 10 pounds of flammable solid
4v	Type 4 Processing more than 10 lbs of magnesium per day	641.00	Type 4 Permit-The melting, casting, heat treating, machining or grinding of more than 10 pounds of magnesium per working day
