BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING
June 24th, 2025

The meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District No. 1 was held on Tuesday evening June 24th, 2025 at the Fire District Office.

President Joseph Parento, commencing with the flag salute, called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The President announced that this meeting is being conducted within the provisions of N.J.S.A.10:4-6 to N.J.S.A. 10:4-41 titled Open Public Meetings and that the time and place has been posted on the bulletin board of the Municipal Buildings and was advertised in the Courier Post on February 6, 2025.

Other members of the Board of Fire Commissioners and appointed persons present were Commissioners: James Bauer, Anthony Quaciari, James Turcich and Joseph Seybert. Also present were: Chief Joseph Cunningham Sr, Deputy Chief Kevin Peak, 232 Batt. Chief/FM Joseph Cunningham Jr, 231 President Greg Boehmke, 231 LT Ralph Bense, 232 Captain CJ Francis, 232 LT Burak Dugme, 232 Trustee J Matzer, Solicitor Carmen Saginario Jr, Insurance Broker Ryan Jones and Clerk Maggie Suter.

A motion was made by Commissioner Quaciari, seconded by Commissioner Seybert, to approve the June 10, 2025 meeting minutes. The Board was polled, all AYES. The motion was approved.

COMMUNICATIONS: Nothing to report.

SECRETARY: Nothing to report.

CHIEF: Report was read and is on file.

G Cunningham is looking into getting the ID Machine being fixed or if we have to purchase a new one.

DEPUTY CHIEF: Report was read is on file.

STATION 231 BATTALION CHIEF: Not in attendance

STATION 232 BATTALION CHIEF: Report was read and is on file.

Looking at ordering new duty crew t-shirts with the new design. A2Z's quote for 250 shirts \$2570, Townline's quote for 250 shirts \$2782.50. The board agreed to go with A2Z.

The board would also like to get a quote for the breast cancer shirts. That can be approved over email.

OFFICE SPACE & EQUIPMENT:

We are waiting on a list from 231 on how many computers they need. Will possibly need a total of 11 or 12 between the two stations.

Maggie brought up that Ready Refresh has combined three companies into one and has been a headache to work with getting our 5 gallon water jugs and pallet of water delivery. Ready Refresh charges \$15.99 a jug plus \$13.99 delivery, W B Mason \$13.99 jug no delivery fee. The board agreed to create an account with WB Mason.

MASTER PLANNING: Nothing to report.

UNIFORMS: Will be placing an order of new Duty Crew Shirts.

J Matzer needs a new class b uniform. The board advised him to go to A2Z.

APPARATUS: 2315 is out of service due to the ladder not working properly.

Each station is missing Hand rollers. Look into getting two hand rollers.

WEBSITE: Up and running.

SAFETY: Nothing to report.

BUILDING & GROUNDS: The Chester Ave station had their entrance pad lifted and sealed.

The Bridgeboro station phone lines are fixed.

Comcast came out and installed the Ethernet Dedicated Internet Service at the district and both stations.

Commissioner Bauer advised he spoke to the Chester Ave station president about the Bunk Room project. That is currently on hold.

GRANT: Chief advised that if we do not get a grant for air packs this year we will put in for it next year. If we do receive the grant for the air packs this year then next year will be new CO Meters.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Nothing at this time.

BILLS FOR PAYMENT: The bills for this meeting \$36,192.89. The total for June \$154,720.08

A motion was made by Commissioner Turcich and seconded by Commissioner Seybert to pay all bills present. The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was carried.

OLD BUSINESS: Commissioner Bauer advised we have to get rid of class b foam per NJDEP and that there are two other types of foam we would like to replace it with.

Delran Fire Department Deputy Chiefs Report

June 24, 2025

Currently we are at 344 calls for service.

Some notable incidents since the last meeting:

June 13th – S2324 responded out to Shamong for a Wildland Urban Interface assignment for the recent forest fire that happened.

June 21st – Engine 2321 covered Cinnaminson Station 201 while they operated on a house fire. Cascade 2319 was also dispatched out and utilized on scene for a period of time.

June 21st – E2321 and Deputy 2301 responded to cover station Lenola station 313 while they were on the scene in Maple Shade, but were returned by command due to the minor nature of the call.

June 23rd – E2321 responded to Cinnaminson for a report of a building fire. First arriving units confirmed that there was no active fire and held the incident to themselves.

Delran FD attended the Graduation of 5 members of the Chester Ave station from graduating Delran High School.

DFD was on storm stand by on June 19th for about an hour and a half while a storm moved through the area and forced central communications to go into their Storm Mode policy. An IAR message blast went out and members staffed 3 trucks while in standby.

The Fire Extinguishers have been serviced at 232, Two water cans needed to be replaced.

Our first batch of SCBA Cylinders were sent out for Hydro and have come back, I have a second batch that needs to be sent out long with the bottles BC Seybert pulled from Station 1. I will be getting a quote for this from a different company; We were not happy with the time and service provided by Kistler.

Marine 23 is in the water, The fire pump needs service again. The Oil housing and supply line is cracked and leaking. I have reached out to Tohatsu several times and we are not receiving a call or email back to get the parts needed. It is my recommendation to replace it with a new pump as we seem to have issues with this pump every year. I have a call into Darley to see what their equivalent is.

The summer heat waves didn't waste any time rolling in, A year ago we received a demo box of "Drip Drop" hydration packets. The members liked them, and it offered us a quick hydration boost for the members coming on crew. I have an email in to get quoted on ordering 2 boxes of these.

I went out to 115 Coopers Kill on June 13th for the joint examination of the fire we had there in May. This turned out to an issue with the Samsung Electric Range which had an outstanding recall and is responsible for 300 plus fire in the last 3 years.
