The meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District #1 was held on Tuesday evening, September 9th, 2025 at the fire district office.

Deputy Chiefs Report

September 9, 2025

Currently we are at 526 calls for service.

Some notable incidents since the last meeting:

August 24<sup>th</sup> – E2312 responded to Willingboro Rittenhouse square neighborhood for a dwelling. They were soon returned due to the nature of the call.

August 29<sup>th</sup> – S2324 responded to Moorestown Township for a dwelling fire in the middle of the day. Crews were recalled and assignment was handled by district 31.

August 30<sup>th</sup> – R2329 and C2319 were redirected to an MVC at Hartford Deli when returning from an assist EMS call. Crews arrived to find a vehicle ¼ way into the building with occupants out. No structural damage occurred and scene was turned over to the owners.

September 2<sup>nd</sup> – E2312, DC2301 and C2300 responded to Willingboro for an LZ assignment but was recalled due to the proximity and patient status.

September 8<sup>th</sup> – E2312 was dispatched to Willingboro for a structure assignment but recalled soon after along with other mutual aid due to the nature of the call.
