

BOARD OF DELRAN FIRE COMMISSIONERS
SPECIAL MEETING
NOVEMBER 17 2025

A special meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District #1 was held on Monday evening November 17, 2025 at the Delran Township Fire District Office.

President Joseph Parento III called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm commencing with the flag salute.

The President announced that this meeting is being conducted in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S. 10:4-6 to N.J.S. 10:4-41 titled Open Public Meetings and that the time and place was advertised in the Courier Post and posted in 5 public places on November 7, 2025.

The President opened the meeting for public comments regarding the capital appropriations.

232 Battalion Chief J Cunningham Jr asked if the budget contained the salaries for Fire Inspectors, the board advised him this meeting is to approve the capital items. This matter can be brought up again at the next business meeting.

Commissioner Seybert made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Turcich to close the comments to the public for the special meeting. The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was carried.

Commissioner Quaciari made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Seybert to adopt Resolution 2025-16 to accept the capital appropriations as posted and discussed. The Board was polled. All Ayes. The motion was carried.

Commissioner Bauer made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Quaciari to allow the Treasurer to appropriate funds as needed for the year 2025. The Board was polled. All Ayes. The motion was carried.

Commissioner Turcich made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Quaciari to adopt Resolution 2025-17 to accept the 2024 audit. The Board was polled. All Ayes. The motion was carried.

Commissioner Bauer made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Turcich to go into a closed door session at 7:50pm. The board was polled, All Ayes. The motion was carried.

As there was no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Commissioner Turcich and seconded by Commissioner Bauer to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 pm. The Board was polled. All Ayes. The motion was approved.
