BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING
February 24, 2026

The meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District No. 1 was held on Tuesday evening February 24, 2026 at the Fire District Office.

President Joseph Parento, commencing with the flag salute, called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The President announced that this meeting is being conducted within the provisions of N.J.S.10-4.6 to N.J.S. 10:4-41 titled Open Public Meetings and that the time and place has been posted on the bulletin board of the Municipal Building and was advertised in the Courier Post on February 13, 2026. It was also posted on the department website in the legal notices section along with the other legal notices we are required to post.

Other members of the Board and appointed persons present were Commissioners James Bauer, James Turcich, and Joseph Seybert. Anthony Quaciari was absent. Also present were: Chief Joseph Cunningham, Sr., Deputy Chief Kevin Peak, 231 Batt. Chief Scott Seybert, 232 Batt. Chief/FM Joseph Cunningham, Jr., 232 Captain Burak Dugme, 232 Lt. Hugh Pierce, 232 Lt. CJ Francis, 231 Trustee Richrd Rossner, 232 Trustee John Matzer, Clerk Elizabeth Briggs, Solicitor Geoff Stark, and Insurance Broker Ryan Jones.

A motion was made by Commissioner Turcich, which was seconded by Commissioner Bauer, to approve the February 10, 2026 meeting minutes. The Board was polled, all AYES. The motion was approved.

COMMUNICATIONS: We received the yearly agreement for Holt McNally & Associates, which has been signed and will be sent back tomorrow.

SECRETARY: Maggie and Liz are working on the list for the insurance renewal. They need the updated list of members to be added and removed.

CHIEF: Report was read and is attached.

DEPUTY CHIEF: Report was read and is attached.

STATION 231 BATTALION CHIEF: Nothing to report.

STATION 232 BATTALION CHIEF: Nothing to report.

STATION PRESIDENTS: Not in attendance.

OTHER LINE OFFICER'S REPORTS: 232 Captain Dugme: Would like to order 10 new pagers. Also has a uniform request. He will get quotes on the pagers and bring them to the next meeting.

232 Lt Pierce: Nothing to report.

FIRE OFFICIAL/ FIRE PREVENTION: Inspections are being done around town.

Sub code official and myself have been in discussion about the 12 buildings that are being put in next to Home Depot. They are currently trying to only have 1 fire pump for all 12 buildings, which is not sufficient.

The other agencies will be out at Winterberry to investigate the fire that happened there.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT (Geoff Stark): Will be here Monday for our drill on harassment.

INSURANCE (Ryan): Report is attached.

TRUSTEES: Richard Rossner has the contract to be signed by the board for the doors at the Bridgeboro Station.

The stove for the Chester Ave station is in and will be installed soon.

FIRE POLICE: The next meeting is at Hainesport.

OEM- Nothing to report.

PUBLIC RELATIONS: The Riverside Sports Night teams are at each station.

FIRE EQUIPMENT:

Chief would like to order 5 cords for the radios- \$910.

2 air packs were put out of service. We need to order 6 new packs, which was requested for the budget. If we order them by April it would be \$72,906.00

Would like to order 4 lengths of forestry hose for \$652.

The board agreed to purchase the forestry hose and the cords.

There was a discussion about the air packs and if it was included on the capital items list.

The President state that it was a capital item on the budget.

A motion was made by James Bauer, seconded by James Turcich to purchase the forestry hose, radio cords, and the 6 air packs. The board was polled, all AYES. The motion was approved.

The guardian lights have been delivered and will be given out to the fire police.

OFFICE SPACE & EQUIPMENT: Nothing to report.

MASTER PLANNING: Nothing to report.

UNIFORMS: 232 Captain needs a few things.

APPARATUS: 2315 is still out being repaired.

WEBSITE: The "Legal Notices" section has been added.

SAFETY: Nothing to report.

BUILDING & GROUNDS: They are very close to finishing the HVAC project. We will be getting a full update soon.

All the snow has been cleared from the snow storms. Thank you to everyone who helped with that.

GRANT: Part of the government is shut down again. There is nothing new to report.

OLD BUSINESS: The Fire wall will be installed very soon.
Laptop for recruitment has been ordered.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Nothing to report.

BILLS FOR PAYMENT: The bills for this evening are \$920,006.09.
\$900,000 of that is the reimbursement to the Township for the HVAC.

NEW BUSINESS:

Joseph Cunningham, Jr.-The 200 Club will be honoring James Turcich, Walter Bauer, and James Bauer for the President's award. Chief Cunningham is getting the distinguished service award. The dinner will be held on March 20th. The department should purchase 2 tables of 10 for \$2,800. A motion was made by James Bauer, seconded by Joseph Seybert to purchase 20 tickets at \$2,800 for the 200 Club awards dinner on March 20. The board was polled, all AYES. The motion was approved.

Our Solicitor Geoff Stark will be teaching harassment on Monday for the mandatory drill.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Nothing to report.

Joseph Seybert- thank you everyone who helped shovel and take care of the stations.
Joseph Parento- thank you everyone who spent all their time at the stations for the storm.

There was no further business to discuss so a motion was made by Commissioner Seybert and seconded by Commissioner Bauer to adjourn the meeting at 8:07 pm. The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was carried.

Delran Fire Department Deputy Chiefs Report

February 24, 2026

Currently we are at 117 calls for service to date

February 10th – S2324 along with DFD chiefs responded to Henry Street in Riverside for a reported house fire. First in units found a active dryer fire and were able to contain to the dryer. Crews remained on scene to assist with ventilation.

February 12th – R2329 responded to Elbo Lane in Burlington Township on the second alarm for a building fire. Once crews arrived, they were staged for a short period of time and then released to Station 301 to remain in coverage for the area.

February 12th – DFD and mutual aid responded to 8008 Route 130NB for a reported possible fire in the building. Crews arrived and found no fire and minor smoke condition from a minor cooking incident. Crews vented and were released.

February 14th – R2329 responded to Edwards Avenue in Delanco on the initial alarm for a working structure fire. On arrival the crews was reassigned to duties on scene to find and extinguish extension of the fire outside of the room of origin.

February 18th – E2312 was dispatched to but recalled enroute to a house fire in Willingboro Township due to the minor nature once crews arrived on scene.

February 19th – DFD and other mutual aid fire police responded to the area of Holy Cross entrance on Route 130SB. Responding units blocked off Route 130SB from Fairview Street to Chester Ave for 4 hours while PD conducted their investigation.

Updated to last months grids meeting: Dave Klotz at Central Communications received the grids and grid mapping and will be going over them and being sure all the necessary changes are made that the Chiefs and Chief Coordinator spoke about.

Annual fit testing has begun for the department. Station 231 has been completed. The fit test for 232 originally scheduled for this past Monday will be rescheduled due to the snow storm that came.

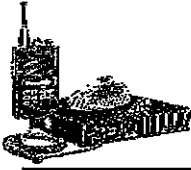
