CAUCUS MINUTES
JANUARY 11, 2022

The regular meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Delran Township Fire District No. 1 was held on Tuesday evening January 11, 2022, at the Fire District Office.

Vice President Anthony Quaciari, commencing with the flag salute, called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The Vice President announced that this meeting is being conducted within the provisions of N.J.S. 10-4.6 to N.J.S. 10:4-41 titled Open Public Meetings and that the time and place has been posted on the bulletin board of the Municipal Building and was advertised in the Burlington County Times on February 10, 2021.

Other members of the Board and appointed persons present were Commissioners James Turcich and James Bauer; Chief Peak; and Lt. #231 Bensel.

Commissioner Turcich made a motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Quaciari to accept December 14, 2021 caucus minutes; the December 28, 2021 regular monthly minutes; and the January 4, 2022 Special Minutes. The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was carried.

Commissioner James Turcich made a motion, which was seconded by James Bauer to adopt Resolution 2022-02 to amend the 2022 District Budget. The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was carried

CHIEF- Chief Peak submitted his written report. (See attached)

OFFICERS- #231 Lt. Bensel reported that Station 231's Installation Dinner was held January 10. The company is organizing duty crews for next month.

FIRE POLICE- The January meeting of the County Fire Police was cancelled due to Covid 19. Our fire police will help Mt. Holly Fire Department with their 5K Run on March 13.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bauer and seconded by Commissioner Turcich to pay all bills presented. The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was carried.

Vice President Quaciari reported that the individual using Station 231 for a wedding is in the process of obtaining insurance coverage for the wedding event that will be held at Station #231.

MASTER PLAN- Commissioner Bauer stated that a meeting will be held January 27.

GRANT- We are currently working on the Safer Grant.

NEW BUSINESS- Firefighter Kenney asked if he could obtain some of the old warning lights from 2315 to be used for parts on his truck. After hearing no objections, Vice President Quaciari stated that FF Kenney could have the old lights.

Vice President Quaciari asked if anyone had any further business to discuss. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Turcich made a motion seconded by Commissioner Bauer to adjourn the meeting at 8:10PM. The Board was polled. All AYES. The motion was approved.

Department had 621 Calls for the year 2021.

Currently we are at 17 calls for the year

1/1 - Rescue 2329 responded into Cinnaminson for an MVC at Route 130 and Andover Road. I arrived first FD unit on scene and recalled our rescue due to nature of the incident.

1/7 - Department assisted DES on a Cardiac Arrest in ShopRite

1/11 - Department was dispatched to but soon recalled due to nature of a cardiac arrest

Working with John Sackett from the county to do some radio updates. Its hard with the bigger trucks to have them update on their own due to the fact they don't operate on a daily basis. I will be meeting with him tomorrow at 232 and possibly 231.

Working with Jeffery Gordon from the ISO office in scheduling a meeting with him and going over the numbers from previous years. This is a normal thing that's scheduled yearly.

231 Had their installation dinner last evening. Officers of 231 were installed as in normal fashion with their tradition.
